ORDER No:-209-JKPCC of 2022

DATED :- 06-09-2022

In Order to regulate the Wood Based Industries in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the Department of Forest, Environment & Ecology Department, Civil Secretariat, Jammu/Srinagar, Govt. of J&K UT has issued **S.O. 321** dated **4th July 2022**, wherein, it has been stipulated that:

Rule 3(ii) "No new wood-based industry shall be installed / operated without consent to establish/ operate from Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Committee/Board"

Accordingly, in pursuance to **S.O. 321** dated **4th July 2022** issued by the Department of Forest, Environment & Ecology Department, Govt. of J&K the operational Guidelines including Siting Criteria for establishment and operation of new Wood Based Industries in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir shall be as under with immediate effect.

Accord of Consent to Establish/Operate for New Wood Based Industries:

Consent to Establish/Operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and Air ((Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 shall be processed by the J&K Pollution Control Committee through online portal (www.jkocmms.nic.in) for which the new Wood Based Industries falling within the purview of S.O. 321 Dated 4th July 2022 shall fulfill the following operational guidelines including siting criteria, as stipulated by the J&K Pollution Control Committee:

Siting criteria for establishment of New Wood Based Industries.

(A) Within Municipal Limits

- (a) No Wood Based Industries using boiler and using air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc) be allowed to establish in Municipal limits.
- (b) For other Wood Based Industries not using boiler and using air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc):

S.No.	Siting Parameters	Distance (in mtrs)
1.	Distance from residential area	50 m
2.	Distance from Silent zones like Educational institutions, Health Care Establishments, Court Complex, Old Age Homage etc.	150 m

(B) Other Areas (excluding Municipal limits and Approved Industrial Areas).

- 1) No new Wood Based Industries shall be allowed to be established within 8.0 Km radius from the boundary of reserved forest. The distance is to be verified by the concerned DFO.
- 2) (a) For Wood Based Industries with boiler and using air emitting pollutant fuels.

S.No.	Siting Parameters	Distance (in m)
1.	Distance from residential area	250 m and no single residential house within 50 mtrs.
2.	Distance from Municipal Limits/ District Headquarters	500 m
3.	Distance from Silent zones like Educational institutions, Health Care Establishments, Court Complex, Old Age Homage etc.	500 m

- 2) (b) For other Wood Based Industries not using boiler and using air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc)

1.	Distance from residential area	50 m
2.	Distance from Silent zones like Educational Institutions, Health Care Establishments, Court Complex, Old Age Homage etc.	150 m

- C). The new Wood Based Industries to be established in industrial areas shall be regulated as per the existing parameters stipulated for other industrial units in the industrial area.
- D) The existing Wood Based Industries shall be regulated as per the existing parameters stipulated for such industrial units from time to time by the J&K Pollution Control Committee.

The Guidelines including Siting Criteria for Establishment and Operation of New Wood Based Industries issued vide J&K Pollution Control Committee Order No. 209-JKPCC of 2022 dt. 06-09-2022 is hereby modified to the extent that:

“No Wood Based Industries using boiler and air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc) be allowed to establish in Municipal limits” instead of *“no wood Based Industries using boiler and using air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc) be allowed to establish in Municipal limits”* in (A)(a), and

“For other Wood Based Industries not using boiler and air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc)” instead of *“For other Wood Based Industries not using boiler and using air pollutant emitting fuel (such as coal, firewood diesel LDO etc)”* in (A)(b) and (B)(2)(b), and

“Old Age Homes instead of *Old Age Homage* in (A)(b)(2), (B)(2)(a)(3) and (B)(2)(b)(2), in advertently mentioned in the J&K Pollution Control Committee order no. referred above.

The modification is deemed to be with effect from 06-09-2022.
