I. At the outset, the Divisional Officer J& K Pollution Control Committee, Baramulla, J&K Pollution Control Committee (JKPCC), Regional Office, Kashmir welcomed the participants of the Public Hearing meeting and committee members, District Officers, NHPC officials and the public. He deliberated on the general specifications of the project including the purpose of holding the public hearing. He conveyed to the public that the proposed Uri-I Stage-II H.E. Project will add another 240 MW of Power in addition to the current existing 480MW Uri Power Station. JKPCC is conducting the public hearing as an



important requirement for the environment clearance of Uri-I Stage-II H.E Project. He highlighted the salient features of the EIA report and apprised the panel and to the public that the project does not require acquisition of private land for its construction activities. Only underground forest land of 17 hectares is required to be diverted for construction of underground structures of the project for which NHPC has already applied for its clearance as per the due procedure. For this purpose, the NHPC has assigned the works of the environment studies of the area to the NABET accredited agency M/s R.S. Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd. Based on the studies, various aspects of the environment and social studies, Environment Impact Assessment/Environment Management plan of the project has been formulated. Further, he added that the said project is a run of river type hydro electric project which is clean and renewable source of energy and hence is having a minimal impact on immediate surroundings.

He further informed the gathering that the M/s. NHPC Limited has proposed establishment of URI-I STAGE-II HE PROJECT which involves construction of underground structures of Head Race Tunnel, Powerhouse and Tail Race Tunnel with a total generation capacity of 240 MW, located between the villages Boniyar and Bandi in Tehsil Uri of Baramulla District J&K. He explained the salient features of the proposed project. As per Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Govt of India, Notification S.O.No.1533(E) dated 14.09.2006, proposed project required to obtain the environmental clearance under the provisions of Environment Protection Act, 1986 and therefore Environmental Public Hearing is mandatory for this project. He informed that the present public hearing is organized to obtain Suggestions, Views, Comments and objections, if any, on the proposed project. These proceedings will be recorded in written and video for submission to Govt. of India.

He informed the forum that as per requirement of Govt. of India, a press notification pertaining to the proposed public hearing was published in "**Rising Kashmir**" and "**Chattan**" daily newspapers on 22.11.2023 and announcement in the villages with the help of public address system and also the draft EIA / EMP report, executive summaries in Urdu and English prepared by R. S. Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd. a regulatory agency approved by Govt. of India, were displayed at i) Office of the District Magistrate, Baramulla ii) District Industries Centre, Baramulla iii) JKPCC , Office, Jammu ~~J&K~~ iv) JKPCC, Regional Office, Srinagar, J&K vi) District Office (JKPCC Baramulla) vii) MoEF & CC, Govt. Of India, Jammu vii) Sub-Divisional Office, Uri, Baramulla District viii) Irrigation & Flood Control Office Baramulla Uri ix) Power

Department Baramulla for public and invite Suggestions, Comments and objections, if any within 30 days from the date of publication.

II. During the proceeding, opportunity was given to the public attended for the public hearing to express their views, suggestions, comments and objections if any on the proposed project. Proceedings of the Public Hearing were recorded and the Minutes are being forwarded to the MoEF & CC, Government of India for examination of proposal while issuing the Environmental Clearance.

III. Demands of local public during the Public hearing process:

1. **BDC Boniyar Sh Bilal Ahmad**, welcomed the District Administration and other committee members and all the people present in the public. He demanded that all the genuine demands shall be addressed by all the Administration and NHPC as per feasibility of the project. He demanded that preference shall given to the local youth for engagement in the construction works related to the Project. Besides he projected the following demands:

- a. Providing of free power to local area of Boniyar and Uri.
- b. Development of Hospital at Boniyar by way of augmenting its machinery.
- c. Dedicated Power Supply to PHC Boniyar by providing DG Set.
- d. Establishment of 6.3 MVA transformer.
- e. Installation of Fire tender at Boniyar.
- f. Development of public places from Boniyar Village to Rajarwani.
- g. Safeguarding water resources of affected areas including Rather Mohalla and other areas of the left bank which are likely to be affected during execution of the project.
- h. Development of drainage pattern from Jamia Mohala to Children.
- i. Development of Bus Stop for winter.
- j. Priority of CSR funds to the local area.

He concluded his speech with thanks to all the officials and assured full cooperation for construction of the project.

2. **Sh Gh Nabi Sheikh** expressed thanks to District Administration, JKPCC and NHPC for organizing the public hearing on the Environment aspect of the project and sought that concern of local people towards environment should be dealt effectively.

- a. Transmission Lines for transmitting the generated power shall be installed/ carried out in such a manner so as to minimize land acquisition for towers.

- b. The indirect benefits like engagement workforce, transportation, construction works shall be prioritized for the local workforce.
 - c. Irrigation facilities shall be restored and revived after successful construction of the project for the affected areas.
 - d. Steps shall be undertaken for provision of free power to the affected local areas.
 - e. Strengthening of embankments of river Jhelum as per requirement.
 - f. Solar Street Light in the area.
 - g. Fire & Emergency Services.
 - h. Drinking water Facilities.
 - i. Mohura project revival of heritage.
3. **Raja Javaid (Sarpanch) Bela Salamabad**, thanked all the officers of District Administration and NHPC and sought engagement of local labour during the construction of the project.
 4. **Mohamad Saleem Market President Boniyar**, representing local market highlighted the need of washroom, lights, besides some beautification works of the Boniyar market.
 5. **Pringle Village Sarpanch** highlighted the need of construction of Water Supply Storage for local area in village Pringle and sought engagement of unemployed local workforce during the construction of the project.
 6. **Altah Ah Mir, Social Activist** highlighted that the development activities should focus on the local areas specific and sought engagement of local labour during the construction of the project. Further he highlighted that Nallah Hapat Khai be developed. Also he sought engagement of local Contractors and hiring of vehicles from affected people only.
 7. **Ab Aziz Khan Bela Salamabad** highlighted that the benefits of the project should be local specific.
 8. **Mohd Aslam (Social Activist)** welcomed District Administration and NHPC for providing the benefits of the project to the locals. And sought engagement of local labour during the construction of the project.

IV. Mr. Naseer S Bhat Sr Manager (Env) presented brief of the EIA study through Power Point Presentation wherein he explained the nuances of the project.

In order to highlight the provisions that has been kept for mitigating the impact on the environment aspect consultant of M/s R.S. Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Sh. Vivek Jhaldiyal provided the insight and presented a power point presentation and highlighted the provisions of the Uri I Stage II H E Project.

V. RESPONSE OF THE MANAGEMENT:

General Manager (Head of Power Station): after welcoming the District Administration and Local People highlighted the fact that without the support of local public the construction of the project would not be possible and assured that the genuine demands of the public shall be addressed in coordination with Distt. Administration and developmental works of the area will be considered as per available resources and feasibility of the project.

Deliberating upon engagement of local labour for the construction of the project General Manager while reiterating that the construction of NHPC Projects across the india local labour is being hired and the same is ensured by way of incorporating the condition in the tender contract for engagement of local labour during the construction.

With regard to the works related to Local area development, he assured that maximum benfits shall be given to the people of local area which are likely to get affected during the execution of the project.

With regard to Irrigation facilities, Solar Street Lights, 6.3 MVA transformer, providing of Fire Tender, Improvement of graveyards Community Works etc. shall be considered in coordination with Distt. Administration after completion of the modalities.

Pachayat Bhawan, at Chandanwari shall be discussed with district Administration and sorted out for the interest of the public.

VI. Response from District Administration Baramulla:

Sh. Zahoor Ahmad Raina, Additional District Magistrate, Baramulla District welcomed the public, Nearby Villagers, NGO's, Media, Management of NHPC Ltd. He was informed about the ~~hydro~~ project developed by NHPC Ltd near Boniyar and other adjacent villages. The public present in the public hearing appreciated the openness for explaining the different aspects of the project in common language which was construed as the most important aspect of the process.

R S Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd. Gurgaon, Environmental consultant was also complimented for putting report of the proposed Uri-I Stage-II HE Project in public domain and briefly explaining the purpose of holding the hearing and other aspects of environmental baseline status (physical and biological environment) and anticipated impacts in the study area as discussed in EIA report and mitigation measures proposed in Environment Management Plan including Corporate Environment Responsibility programme.



28/11 He also exhorted upon the NHPC that the proposed project shall explore the possibility for indirect employment opportunities for hiring of services from local area in the surrounding

of project area. He also stated that the proposed project will improve the development of the infrastructure facilities in the surrounding villages.

A Committee will be formed for undertaking study on the impact of the project over irrigation and developmental activities. The plan shall be formulated for the development of the local areas. Concerned Departments in coordination with NHPC shall work out the local area development plan. The area has potential for developing a tourist place that can result in the generation of employment to the local youth. For this reason, the CSR needs to be dovetailed for such activities. He highlighted that Irrigation and local drinking water shall not get affected during execution of the project. He further asserted that there shall a proper arrangement for disposal of the muck emanating during execution of the project. Since the area is earthquake sensitive zone, all measures need to be taken for this end.

He informed the public that entire proceedings of the public hearing are video recorded and issues raised are also recorded in minutes which shall be sent to Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, New Delhi for further necessary action.

UNSC should be vigilant to dangers of unsustainable financing that leads to vicious cycle of debt traps: India

United Nations, Nov 21: India has told a Security Council meeting presided over by China that the international community should be vigilant towards dangers of unsustainable financing which leads to vicious cycle of debt traps.

"Peace is elusive and development efforts in fragile economies are constrained to exist. Hence, India in various fora, including in the current G20 presidency has worked towards reform of International Financial Institutions," Counselor to India's Permanent Mission to the UN R. Madhavan said on Monday.

Madhavan was speaking at the Security Council 80th anniversary celebration of the International Peace and Security. Promoting Sustainable Peace through Development, held under China's Presidency of the 80th anniversary of the UN's creation in the month of November.

He said as the concept of peace is elusive, the international community should be vigilant towards dangers of unsustainable financing which leads to vicious cycle of debt traps.



He further noted that similarly, peace is "elusive as in our lived experiences where the UN representing the international community struggled to maintain the peace in the aftermath of World War II, and the threat of nuclear war, and the threat of terrorism, and the threat of climate change, and the threat of technological change."

Madhavan said. He added that while comprehensive vision of international security must encompass the interdependence of the UN system's three pillars—peace and security, development, and human rights—it is important to remember that this does not imply that the Security Council should assume all these functions.

"Security is multidimensional, but the Security Council's involvement in every aspect including the economic and social issues might not be advisable," he said.

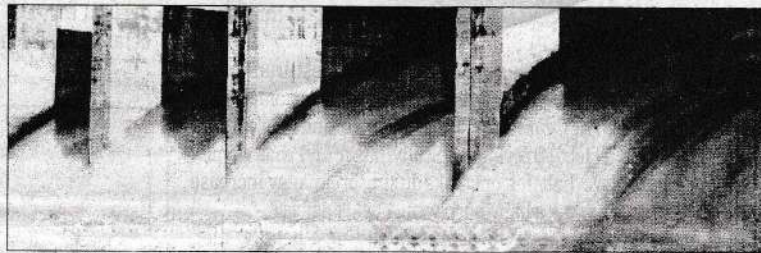
