## Minutes of Public Hearing

Public hearing was conducted on 21st Feb 2024, at Industrial Estate Khonmoh, Phase II for Minor Mineral Quarry Cluster Masonry Stone Block at Khasra No 2610 Min Area 5.72 Ha Village Khomoh, Tehsil Panthachowk District Srinagar and Shri Mohd Amin Wani Khasra No 147, Area 8.92 Ha village Dakteng (Zewan) Tehsil Panthachowk, District Srinagar.

Notice for the public hearing was issued by the Member Secretary J&K pollution control board committee on 19-01-2024, which could not be conducted at a proposal site due to the weather condition on previous day (20th Feb 2024), thus the site was shifted from Industrial Estate Khonmoh- I Near Sidco office , Srinagar District J&K to Warehouse Hall Industrial Estate Khonmoh II as tent could not be erected due to heavy snow before the scheduled date. Wide publicity was given to the public hearing Notice through newspapers, banners were displayed in and around both the vicinities also bills were pasted in the Khonmoh And Zewan localities and announcement were made in the both the localities on P.A System installed on a vehicle.

A large number of inhabitants of village Khonmoh And Zewan as well as adjoining areas participated in the public hearing their names

were recorded and are enclosed here with as Annexure-A. The entire proceedings of the public hearing were photo-graphed and video graphed. The video-graphy of the public hearing is enclosed as Annexure-B. The participants were given the opportunity to present their opinions regarding the proposed activity.

Following spoke on the podium and expressed their views.

1] The public hearing was started with the inaugural welcome speech by **Sh. Fiaz Ahmad Pajwari, Divisional Pollution Control Committee Srinagar**, wherein the general public were welcomed and thanked for participating. He explained to the audience the purpose of conducting the public hearing and ensured participants the opinion of the public, whether in favour or opposition of proposed project should be put forth before the designated panel of officers with open mind and without any fear and favour. So that a true picture is reflected/conveyed same to the higher authorities for taking a decision in this regard.

It may be added here, before the welcome address, the guests were presented with bouquets.

2] **Sh. Anand Sharma Consultant of M/S Globus Environment Engineering Services** gave a detailed account of the proposed project for Block at Khasra No 2610 Min, of Area 5.72 Ha at Village Khonmoh and at Khasra no 147 Area 8.92 Ha at Dakteng (Zewan), before the general public present and panel of officers for conducting a public hearing. The consultant give the live demonstration, as he could not reach due to the having snow, day before scheduled date as Air Traffic was disturbed. The consultant laid emphasis on the socio-economic benefits which would occur on the coming up of the said activity. The consultant gave the brief description of the proposed mining activity to be conducted in both blocks separately. He also

informed that quarry lease was granted by General Manager Geology & Mining vide letter no 373/Mcc/DGM/CQK/16/B520-22 dated 22/08/2017 for the exploitation for 5 years, applicant the higher e-bidder, thus letter of intent was issued for khasra no. 2610 Min Area 5.72 Ha village Khonmoh Srinagar & LOI by DGM office vide letter no. 377/MCC/DGM /CQK/16/3520-.dated 22/08/2017 for exploitation for 5 years, with mode of operation open cost semi-mechanized, capacity 2,00,000 MT/A and 1,50,000 MT/A which works around mining of 666.66.T/day and 500 MT/day respectively. The Consultant assured the public that the promoter shall plant 570 and 446 in Khonmoh and Zewan quarries per year, They will also construct a toilet for women nearby the primary school and install (High Mast) Street Solar Lights, 8 and 15 in number, which will cost 2.13 Lakh and Rs 4.87 Lakhs for both the quarries, on being enquired about the maintenance of these assets, the consultant assured it is promotor's responsibility to look after & maintain these after the lapse of lease time if the mines are not renewed the assets will be handed over the panchayat. The consultant also presented the physical features of the site, like project location, type of land, land utilization pattern , sanctioned lease area , proposed production, method of mine lease, pillar coordinates, total geological reserves, total mineable reserves, production on yearly basis as well on day basis, no. of working day, working hours /day, no. of workers , no. of vehicles movement /day, Altitude of mining ground water level, water requirement for drinking purpose, land reclamation/plantation, Mine operation dust suppression.

The consultant also gave the present scenario of the environment data collected in relation to proposed mining for

Ecology and Bio-diversity and about the Socio-Economy benefits the proposed project will have on nearby public.

The consultant also briefed the audience about the different parameters monitored in and around the site of

Ambient Air Quality.

Noise quality

Water quality sampling and analysis of ground water as well as surface water.

Soil quality.

The consultant further apprised about anticipated environmental impacts and mitigation measures about:

Biological environment:- Direct impact, Indirect Impact and cumulative impact on biological environment.

Anticipated impacts and evaluation and mitigation measures of Air Environment & Water Environment.

Noise Environment Anticipated impacts and evolution and Mitigation measures.

Consultant also apprised about the environment monitoring programme about schedule and parameters.

An official told Kashmir Scroll that Ali Mohammed Nagar, son of Abdul Gaffar Nagar, 75, fell from a height of 10 feet from under-construction building.

"He was shifted to GMC Hospital Baramulla for treatment, where he has succumbed to his injuries," the official said.

"Medico-legal formalities are underway following which the body will be handed over to the family for last rites," the official said further.

One person died on the spot and 17 others were injured, the officials said, adding that the injured were hospitalised.

## 'Ramay' Ayodhya set for consecration ceremony, temple town decked up


Pran Pratishtha" ceremony will begin at 12.20 pm and is expected to end by 1 pm

## MHA think tank alerts against 'hijack', sextortion, impersonation scams on WhatsApp

A police think tank here under the Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has issued an advisory to the public on WhatsApp (WA) account and requests users from their contacts to be wary.

"Some people also are using WhatsApp (WA) to receive calls from unknown numbers. These were basically sextortion based fake video calls which were then used to threaten the user."

The Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPRD) has issued a circular on types of such fake video calls, including sextortion through mixed male video calls in the name of job offers and investment plans, impersonation, libelous and secession.

As part of the black

list, the right page advisory has said that the members take immediate action to the victim's WhatsApp (WA) account and request users from their contacts to be wary.

"Some people also are using WhatsApp (WA) to receive calls from unknown numbers. These were basically sextortion based fake video calls which were then used to threaten the user."

The Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPRD) has issued a circular on types of such fake video calls, including sextortion through mixed male video calls in the name of job offers and investment plans, impersonation, libelous and secession.

The BPRD is a think

tank on policing subjects under the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA).

WhatsApp on its part has launched a number of public awareness campaigns in the recent past to advise the use to the public about the safety features brought in by the platform, said by technology advisor Meenakshi.

The BPRD said through mixed calls made from main users sharing with country codes usually belonging to Pakistan, Kenya, Ethiopia and Malaysia, users had used code names for their contacts.

## Six fresh Covid deaths reported in country

India has logged 209 fresh cases of Covid, while the number of active cases of the infection in the country has reached 1,068, the health ministry said on Sunday.

Six deaths, four from Kerala and one each from Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh - have been reported in邦里. The total number of deaths now stands at 5,600.

The number of daily cases has dropped to below 200 till December 31, 2023, but they again began to increase after emergence of a new variant and could well be continued.

The current tally suggests that the BA.5 variant is on the rise due to a combination of weather conditions.

India has witnessed three waves of COVID-19 in the past year, with the peak incidence of early 2021.
